DRESS CODE

Please dress modestly when visiting.

For Women:








- Modest, loose-fitting clothing
- Clothing that covers the legs (e.g. trousers, maxi skirts or dresses)
- Headscarves are optional

For Men:



- Modest clothing
- Long trousers preferred (no shorts)
- Sleeveless tops discouraged; short sleeves are acceptable



ETIQUETTE & CONDUCT

-  Shoes must be removed at the door before entering any part of the mosque
-  Mobile phones must be silenced; please speak quietly
-  No photography or filming is permitted anywhere on the premises
-  Prayer observation is not permitted in the main prayer hall
-  Respect gender-separated areas as indicated by signs
-  No food or drink to be consumed in the prayer areas
-  Respectful conduct is expected at all times; questions are welcome after your visit
